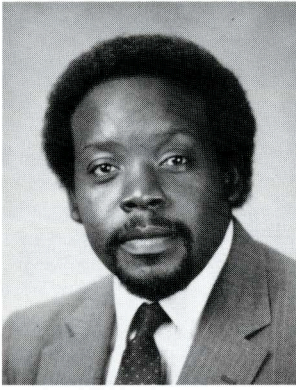
Since July, 1971, Lanny Henninger has served as pulpit minister of the University Avenue Church of Christ in Austin.

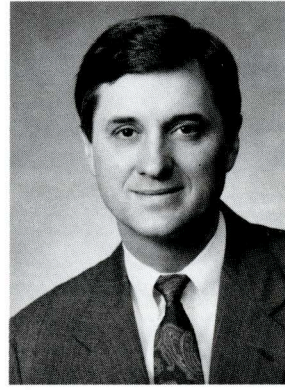

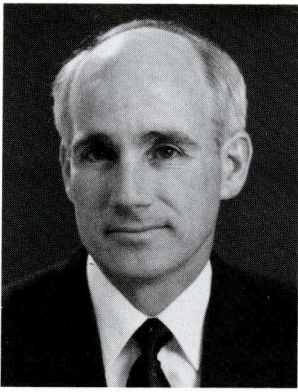

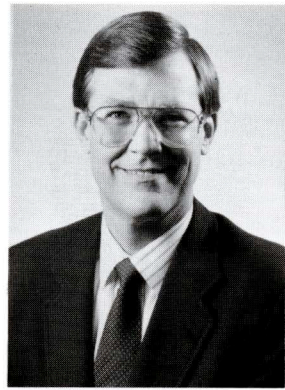

Becton and his wife, Camilla, have four children.



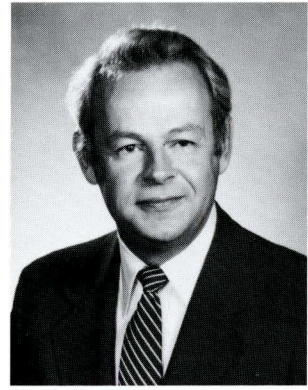

Philip Slate currently serves as chairman of the Department of Missions at ACU. From 1986-92 Slate served as dean of the Harding University Graduate School of Religion, where he also served as a professor until 1993. He taught Bible at the Mill Hill School in London and was the head of Wembly Bible School in London.

He has preached for congregations in Tennessee, Kansas and London, as well as working in mission situations in Belgium, Singapore, Malaysia, the Philippines, Japan and Taiwan.

Additionally, Slate was a consultant to missionaries in Argentina, Brazil, Belize, Guatemala, Japan, Singapore, Kenya, Germany, England and the Philippines. He holds a bachelor's degree from David Lipscomb University, a master's degree from Harding Graduate School of Religion and a doctorate in Missiology from Fuller Theological Seminary.

He and his wife, the former Patricia Finch, have three children.

Over the past 40 years, Tony Ash has served as pulpit minister for congregations in Georgia; California; and Texas, including Red Springs, Austin and Abilene.

Currently, he preaches for the Minter Lane Church of Christ in Abilene. He also serves as a professor of Bible at ACU. He has done evangelistic work in more than 35 states and eight foreign countries.

Ash received an associate's degree from Florida Christian College, a bachelor's degree from Florida State University in 1956, a master's degree from ACU in 1959, and a Ph.D. from the University of Southern California in 1966.

During his teaching career, he has taught courses at ACU; Pepperdine University, where he was chairman of the religion division; and the Institute for Christian Studies, where he was an A.B. Cox Professor.

He has published eight books including *Prayer*; *Deciding to Love*; *Dealing with Divorce*; *The Word of Faith*; and commentaries on Luke, Acts 1-12, Jeremiah and Lamentations, and Psalms, with Clyde Miller.

He is married to the former Barbara Bailey.

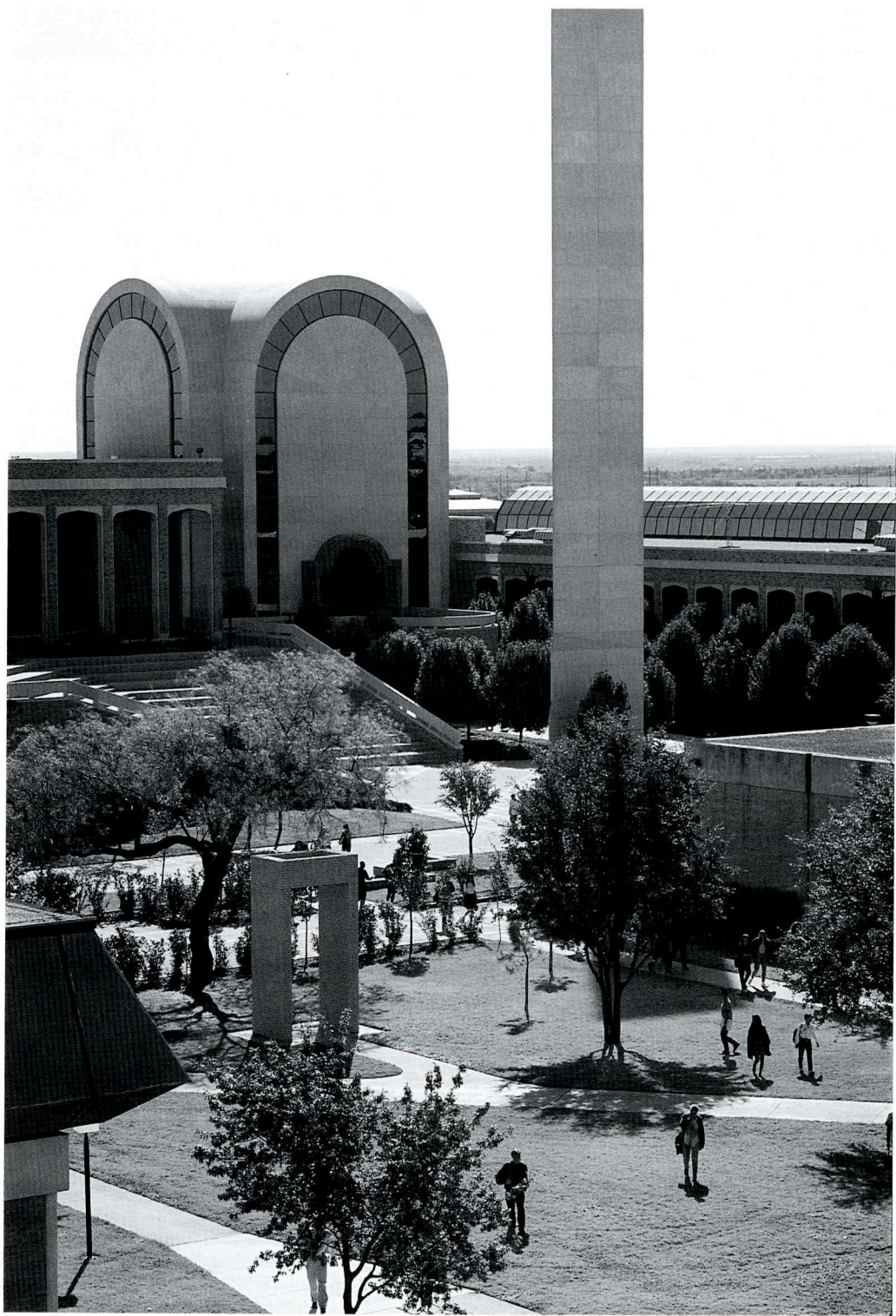

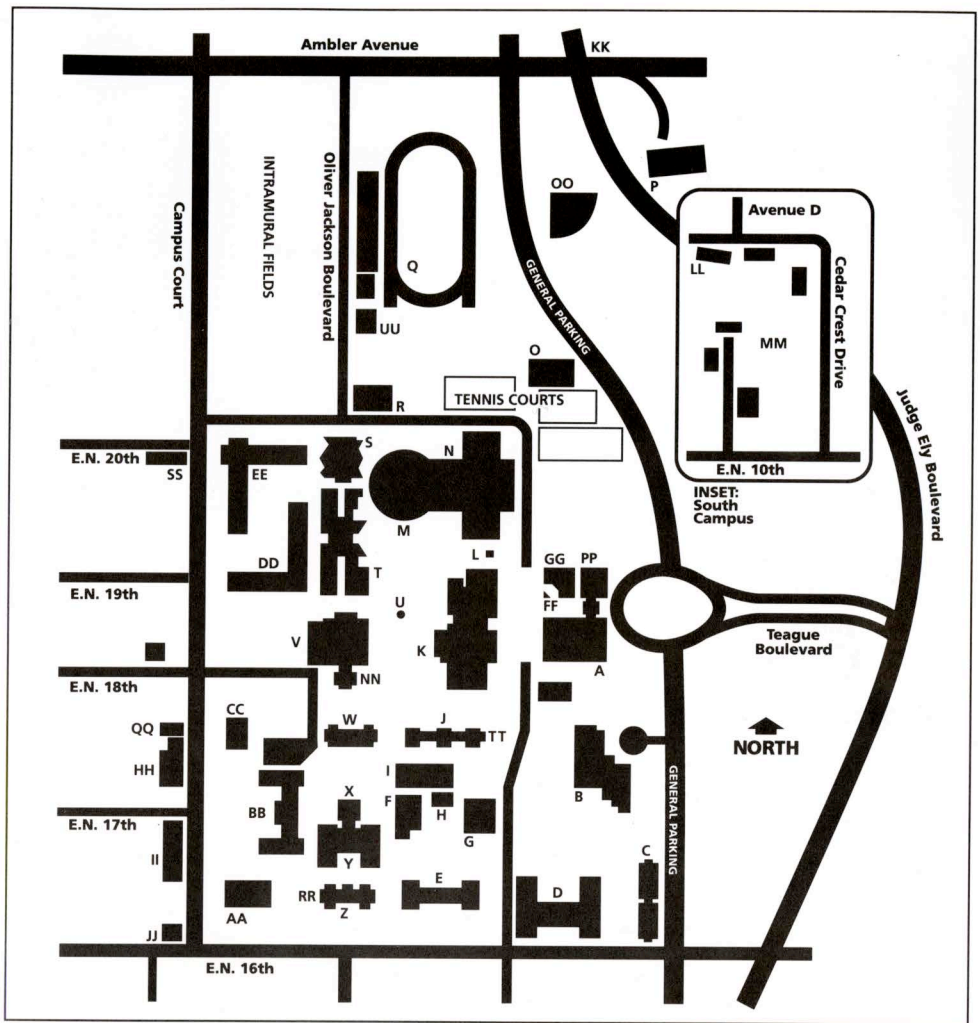
