## INFORMATION

**Dates:** July 25-28, 1982

**Place:** Abilene Christian University, Mabee Library Auditorium

**Registration:** Begins at 3:00 p.m., Sunday, July 25, 1982, McGlothlin Campus Center.

**Cost:** \$8 per person, on arrival at Registration (Same fee for one class or the entire Workshop).

\$150 for churches wishing to register all their teaching force (elders may be included in this group registration fee). However, the group fee applies only if sent in advance and postmarked on or before July 12. After that date the regular fee will apply.

Congregations more than 500 miles from Abilene who go together and charter a bus may register at the rates for a single congregation.

**Rooms:** On-campus housing is available on a first-come, first-served basis, in air-conditioned dormitories, with two or three persons assigned to each room. Rooms are equipped with two single beds. Each person should bring his own linens, including pillows. Couples and families are welcome. No charge is made for children in the room with parents if the family furnishes cots and bedding.

Cost for dormitory housing is \$15 per person, payable as you arrive on campus. This is a fixed housing fee for the Workshop, regardless of how many nights you stay. If you desire on-campus housing, you should make your request in writing **immediately**. Please give all details, including name, home address, telephone, congregation, and congregation address.

**Motels:** Abilene offers a wide choice of hotel and motel rooms for those unable to obtain on-campus housing.

**Meals:** Meals will be available in the University's Cafeteria at the regular rates, or special meal tickets may be obtained, at the rate of \$2.80 per meal. **SPECIAL NOTE:** The Cafeteria is closed on Sunday evenings.
