Dear Brother Larimore:-

The Trustees are Compelled by force of circumstances to delay the delivery of your home; until their finances are relieved by returns from the sale of some of the lots and lands of Dixfield College.

The Trustees also believe that it would be the better plan to build a new home for you, which could be arranged to meet your requirements, and better suited to your convenience, and at a more reasonable price, than a place already built. or the present, and until such time as the Trustees shall carry out this part of their original agreement with you, they will continue to provide the home for you at their charges, and so far as can be foreseen, it will be perfectly agreeable to all concerned for you to remain at the present place, until that time.
