REGISTRATION

The Registration fee for the Conference is \$8 per person, payable at Registration, as you arrive on campus. The fee is the same whether you register for one session or for the entire Conference. Each person attending must register and pay the fee.

Registration will begin at 1:00 p.m. Friday, July 23, in the Foyer of the Mabee Library Auditorium.

ROOMS

On-campus housing is available on a first-requested, first-assigned basis, in air-conditioned dormitories, with two or three persons assigned to each room. Rooms are equipped with two single beds.

Each person should bring his own linens, including pillows. The cost for dormitory housing is \$15.00 per person, payable as you arrive on campus. This is a fixed housing fee for the Conference, regardless of how many nights you stay. If you plan to bring your family or if you plan to stay for Bible Teachers Workshop, Elders Workshop, or Ministers Renewal Workshop, you need to notify us in advance of your plans. You should make your request in writing immediately if you desire on-campus housing. Please give all details, including name, home address, and telephone number.
