Dear Barney:--

I am in receipt of your favor of the 29th inst. with reference to the desired loan of twenty five or thirty thousand dollars on the holdings of the Trustees of the Dixieland College, and I am unable to put you in touch with any one at this time who could advance the money for the purposes outlined in your letter.

I note your suggestion with reference to securing a loan from my aunt, Mrs. Swearingen, but she is not now in position to make this loan inasmuch as all of her spare funds have been invested. My mother has no idle money at this time either and by careful management we have been able to secure ten percent (10%) on practically all of her loans.

There has been good demand for money in this section and I know of no idle money whatever. A great many residences as well as brick blocks are now going up in the city which has caused a demand for some money and the people of the county as a whole are using a great deal of money in developing their farms.

I trust that you and yours are enjoying the best of health and that I may have the pleasure of seeing you before a great many months have passed. With kind personal regards, I am
