

WHERE WILL YOU SPEND ETERNITY?

Intro, Mt. 7:13-14

1. There are only two ways - leading to one of two destinies.
2. Every responsible person in one of these ways - saved or lost.
3. Either for the Lord or against. Mt. 12:30

I. FROM BIRTH TO RESPONSIBILITY

1. The age of innocence. It is birth, accountability, responsibility, then must come decision.
2. Cradle to account. - age of safety Mk. 10:14; Lk. 18:16
3. Training period.

II. TWO WAYS FOR THE RESPONSIBLE

1. Two leaders, two gates opened, two ways presented, two destinies.
2. Decision must be made - decision determines direction and direction determines destiny Deut. 30:15; Josh. 24:15; Mt. 11:28-30

III. NARROW WAY (How entered)

1. "Strait" demands best in life Mt. 7:13
2. Way of church, blood, truth and life Jn. 14:6
3. Upward and heavenly Heb. 6:1-3
4. Must watch as walk therein. 2 Cor. 10:12; Heb. 3:12-13; 2 Pet. 1:5-11.
5. Broad enough for all redeemed - too narrow for world. Isa. 35:8
6. Way of security Rm. 8:28
7. Few travel it. Only road to heaven.

IV. BROAD WAY.

1. Popular way. - way of many Mt. 7:14
2. Way of world. I Jn. 2:15-17 3. Seems right. Prov. 14:12; Mt. 7:21-24
4. Way of death and destruction Mt. 16:26; 2 Thess. 1:7-9

CONCLUSION

1. Every man inevitably comes to the end of the way Heb. 9:27
2. It is either then heaven or hell Jn. 5:28, 29 Mt. 25:31-46
3. It is either eternal bliss and happiness or eternal destruction.
