

TREES: HAIKU FROM ROOTS TO LEAVES, part of the <u>Sci-ku Haiku</u> series, demonstrates the life cycle and wonder of trees through the use of rich, colorful, gouache illustrations by Angela Mckay and haikus by Sally Walker. The book discusses seeds, roots, limbs, trunks, sap, and rings along with the ways that trees support mankind. The book includes great diversity in the illustrations and provides a time line, background information, a glossary, and a bibliography for readers to explore.

While the book is listed for grades 2-4, I believe that students in upper elementary and middle school would like this book as well. This book integrates poetry, history, and science in a fun and interesting way.
