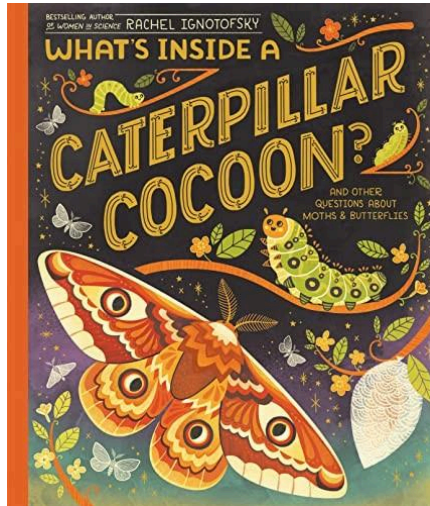

This Junior Library Guild Selection, WHAT'S INSIDE A CATERPILLAR COCOON?, uses illustrations created traditionally and digitally to answer questions about moths and butterflies. The book describes the similarities and differences between moths and butterflies and discusses the life cycle of each. The earth-toned illustrations draw the reader in to learn more on each page.

The book is intended for students in PreK-2 but could be used with older students. The author includes a Sources and Resources page that lists a bibliography and educational activities. In addition, both Random House and the author have websites dedicated to this book which provide more student activities.
