My Dear Sir:-

I note that Dixieland College will be established with yourself as President. When you are ready for the plans for this institution, I shall be pleased to furnish them for you.

I have had a wide experience in college work, as you will note from the references on the enclosed circular, and in addition to these references, I have recently done the work for Mississippi Normal College, a new institution being established at Hattiesburg. With the experience that I have had in such buildings, I should be able to save you considerable money in the actual cost of your work, besides securing for you buildings that are thoroly up-to-date and in every way suited to your needs.

I am sending you a cut of bird's eye view prepared for Mississippi College, showing the future development of this institution, and I have done work of like character for the Mississippi A. & M. College, the Girls Industrial Institute & College at Columbus, Miss., and the University of Mississippi. I am also to do similar work for the Mississippi Normal College.

A drawing of this character is valuable, as it insures uniformity of design, and many times avoids mistakes in changing administrations.
