

In spite of the fact that there is nation-wide publicity on the value of making a will there are still many people who have not gotten around to doing just that.

Robert Sharpe, an estate planning consultant of Memphis, Tennessee reported that **last year 70 per cent of the 1.9 million Americans who died waited too long and died intestate (without a will).**

Thus costs were multiplied in settling the estates. Provisions they undoubtedly would have made in disposing of their resources were not followed because the laws of the state pay no attention to things like this unless they are provided for in a will!

Just imagine, 1,330,000 people dying and having nothing to say about the disposition of their wealth!

Good Christian Stewardship demands that we make a will. Surely God expects us to take care of the blessings He has given us in our lifetime. "Moreover it is required in a steward that a man be found faithful."
