

Robert Sharpe, an estate planning consultant of Memphis, Tennessee reported that last year 70 per cent of the 1.9 million Americans who died waited too long and died intestate (without a will).

Thus costs were multiplied in settling the estates. Provisions they undoubtedly would have made in disposing of their resources were not followed because the laws of the state pay no attention to things like this unless they are provided for in a will!

Just imagine, 1,330,000 people dying and having nothing to say about the disposition of their wealth!
