JACKSONVILLE MAN TO LAY OUT THE DAYTONA PARK

Daytona, Dec. 20.—The Daytona Library and Park Association held a meeting at Mrs. Menefee Huston's, and voted to accept practically the plans submitted by Charles P. Warner, the Jacksonville landscape gardener. There were a few changes they deem wise to make. For instance, the Park Association think it would be well, for a time, at least, to have a tennis court, and to make provision for croquet and such like diversions.

Of course, there will be the resting and lounging places. Mr. Warner's plans provide for a pavillion and comfort station, fountains, vine-covered pergola, band stand, library as it exists, pavillion or lookout, bridge across the channel, palms canariensis, shrubbery, flower beds, hedges, etc.
