Dear Bro Colson:-

Yours of the 13th to hand and it has set a new train of thoughts in my head. For some time I have been thinking of changing my location just for one reason, I am away off here in one corner where it makes my traveling expenses extra heavy. Because of that I have been thinking of getting more centrally located, I am being urged to go to Dodge City, which would be a decided improvement on location, but Gainesville would be better.

I own my own home here, and after eleven years of sojourn here, I love the place, the work and the people. And find it hard to make up my mind to move yet. I find myself wondering if it is

fair or just to the cause to entail
this extra expense to gratify my
pleasure.

I have no regular appointment
here, but try to be here at least one
Sunday in the month. I am here
many work days and put in a
lot of work during that time.

The Church here gives me
the 1st and 4th Sundays contribution
which will average \$16⁰⁰ per month.
I don't suppose that they would
keep that up if I was to move away.

If I could see my home here
I would like to buy here. If not
possibly I could rent and balance
accounts.

Now, I have written you freely
and freely the situation. Think about
it, and write me as I have written
you.
