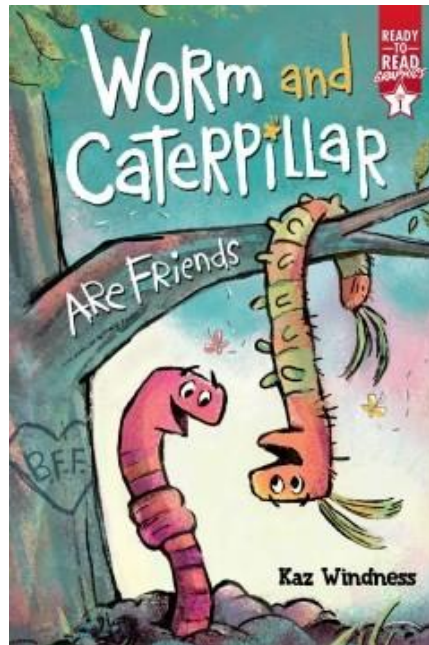

Book Review: WORM AND CATERPILLAR ARE FRIENDS

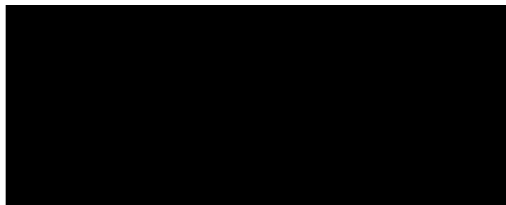

His life cycle has taken the next step. Worm misses his friend but takes care of him for many days. Then one day, Caterpillar comes out of his pupa as a beautiful butterfly. Worm thinks Caterpillar is now a bird since he can fly. Caterpillar (Butterfly) assures him they are still friends. After all, he prefers nectar as his meal.

The graphic novel layout is not complicated for younger readers. It is a Level 1 Ready-to-Read Graphics from Simon Spotlight.
