Dear Sir:-

Your letter of the 12th to Bro. Larimore has been referred to me. The five-acre truck farm tracts in Dixieland Park will sell for \$1000.00 each, payable \$200.00 down and \$200.00 a year with 8% interest on the deferred payments. The residence lots, each about 100 by 200 ft. in size, will sell for \$500.00 to \$1000.00 each, according to location; terms one-fifth down and one-fifth per annum with interest on the deferred payments.

This land could not be better located, and it is the best trucking land around Gainesville. To show what the land will do, Mr. Wells of Gainesville cultivated two acres of this same land and made about \$11,000.00 in two years; his crop was lettuce and cucumbers. Some of this land is in cultivation now and some of it is timber land. We could sell you some that is now in cultivation. Of course everyone could not hope to make what Mr. Wells did every year, but it shows the possibilities of the soil and that the price asked for the land is not excessive.

We believe that a small dairy properly conducted would pay very well. Would be glad to see you down here to investigate the property.
