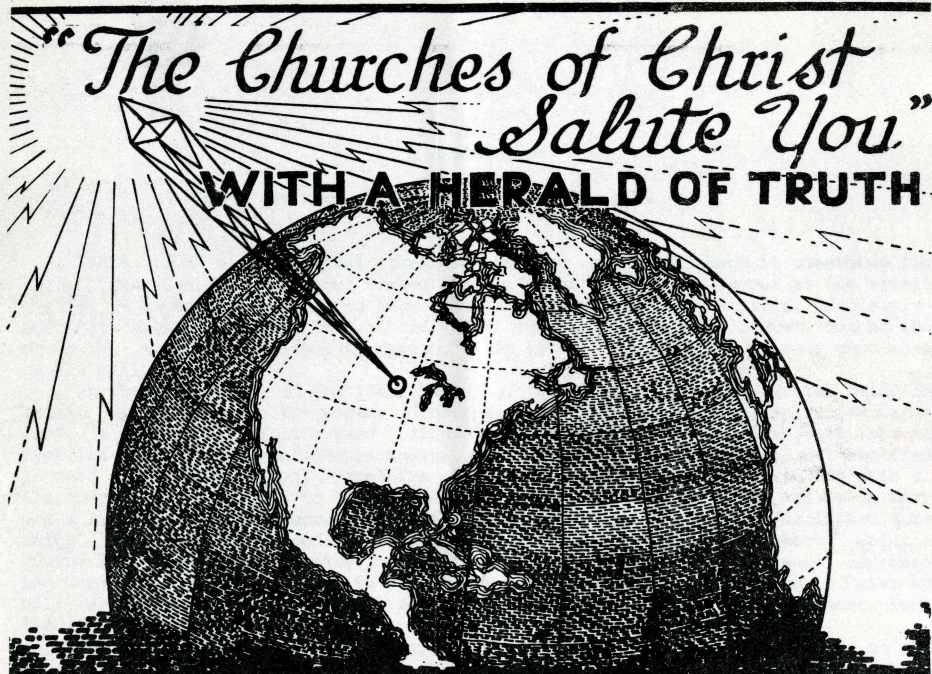

## A DEVOUT MAN

By James W. Nichols--January 27, 1952

There is an old spiritual that has a phrase running through it something like this: "Everybody talking about Heaven ain't a going there." As joyous as the spiritual is, it is still depressing to know these words are true. Christ said, "Not every--one that sayeth unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter the Kingdom of Heaven, but he that doeth the will of my Father in Heaven." It is unfortunate that so many good moral people will be lost.

In the first verse of the 10th chapter of the book of Acts, the writer being inspired by the Holy Spirit wrote, "There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion, of the band called the Italian band." I believe that this man typifies a large number of people today, men and women who are sincere, but who stand in need of God's salvation. Cornelius was a devout man in that he feared God with all his house; gave much alms to the people; and prayed to God always. He was not a thief or a liar. He hadn't spent his life in unrighteous living. Yet, he lacked something. Even with his good and righteous moral life, he still fell short. Peter is quoted in Acts the 11th chapter and the 14th verse, as he tells of an angel approaching Cornelius, who said, "Send to Joppa and call for Simon, whose surname is Peter who will tell you words whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved." A paradox, isn't it? A devout man, who gave and prayed, but who needed to be saved.

Cornelius was like so many today, good, zealous, but lost, and yet he was so different. He accepted the fact that he needed something more when the angel spoke to him. It is becoming so popular for people today to say, "The church doesn't have anything to do with saving us. We have to save ourselves. We have to be clean and pure; a good neighbour and a good citizen. I am just as good as any one in the church. I don't lie; I don't steal; I don't commit murder." No, we don't do any of these things but the question is, "What do we do?"

Now, this man Cornelius, believed in God, lived a good life, prayed unto God, and yet he needed more. Therefore, the Lord came to Peter in a vision to prepare Peter to go and preach to Cornelius. You know the story--how when Peter was up on a house top that a vision came to him. All manner of animals and fourfooted beasts were let down in a great sheet, and the Lord spoke to Peter, saying, "Take, kill and eat." But, Peter said "Not so, Lord, for I have never eaten anything that is common or unclean." The sheet was drawn up. Again the vessel was let down, and again Peter refused. Three time it was let down and each time Peter refused. Then the spirit speaking unto Peter said, "What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common."

The Lord was using this vision to prepare Peter's hardened old heart, to go and preach the gospel to Cornelius, too. You know, Peter was just like a lot of us are--human. He sinned just as you and I do. Why, the apostle Paul said, "I withstood Peter to his face, for he was to blame."

Peter was hardened against the Gentiles. He believed that the Lord had limited his salvation, and that he was to preach only to the Jews. But the vision sent by the Lord softened up Peter's heart. So when the men that Cornelius sent to find Peter came, Peter was ready to go with them. The vision has made him see that Christ came to seek and to save that which was lost whether it was Jew or Gentile. He was willing to go, and preach the gospel, because God has used a miracle to open his eyes and his heart. So he started on his journey, not knowing what would happen, perhaps doubting a little bit in his mind that he should even go. But he went, because he believed that the Lord was willing. When he reached the house of Cornelius, he said to Cornelius, "Thy prayer is heard; and thine alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God."

There was another remarkable thing about Cornelius. Not only did he pray and give, but he worked. Cornelius had gathered together those in his household, and was waiting for Peter. He had called together his kinsmen and his near friends. He had a



deep yearning for the security of their souls as well as his own. How I wish I could imprint upon the hearts of men today that we must be filled with the zeal and love for our brethren, if souls are to be saved. Some Christians think so much of their friends that they are afraid to speak to them about their souls. They are afraid they might offend them. What could be worse than to have our friends point at us in the day of judgment, and accuse us for not teaching them the truth? It takes a real friend to speak to us the Truth.

Anyway, Cornelius was interested. So he gathered his friends and kinsmen together, and Peter was ready to preach. He preached just as he did on the day of Pentecost. The Holy Spirit, speaking through Peter, told how that Christ had come to this earth of sin and sorrow, and left his heavenly home. He told them how Christ had walked and talked with him and with the other apostles, and perhaps thousands of others, teaching them things that pertain unto life and godliness. He told how Christ was willing to forsake the things of this life to live in poverty, to save mankind. Perhaps, not only did he imprint upon the heart of Cornelius how Christ was rejected and forsaken, but even told of how he, Peter, had stumbled and fallen and even denied the Lord. He told how the Lord went on to the death of the cross. I know that he must have implanted deep into the heart of Cornelius the story of Jesus.

When Peter had preached this mighty sermon, the scripture says, "While Peter yet spake those words, the Holy Spirit fell on all of them which heard the word, and they of the circumcision which believed were astonished; as many came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, 'Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?' And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days." Here was the result of a man being devout; an honest man; a man who loved God, and feared God with all his house. He sent for a preacher; he heard his word; the Holy Spirit came upon him as by a miracle of God, and he was commanded to be baptized in the name of the Lord.

Today, men and women say, "I live a good life; I am devout; I fear God with all my house," and yet they will stop there. Notice this: when Cornelius had realized that there was more for him to do, he sent for a preacher; he gathered together his friends and neighbors, and when he heard the word he obeyed it. Oh, why can't we do that today? Why can't we accept the Lord? Why can't we just submit ourselves to Him and His love, and obey all of his commandments?

I want us to notice here, that the scripture says, "While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Spirit fell on all them which heard the word." It is a popular doctrine today for men to say, "The Holy Ghost comes upon us, and then after we've been saved, we can be buried with our Lord in baptism. I know there are many people who are honestly and sincerely believing this, but I think that if we study the word of God closely; diligently; sincerely, we will find that his is not the teaching of the New Testament. Remember, the angel had told Cornelius that Peter would tell him what he must do to be saved. Now then, the Holy Spirit coming down on Cornelius was not something that Peter had told him to do. The scripture says that Peter and the other Jewish Christians present were astonished. Therefore, the coming of the Holy Spirit couldn't have been the thing that Peter was to command that Cornelius and his household might be saved. Notice again; it says that, "While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all of them which heard the word." And then again, Peter says that, "These have received the Holy Ghost as well as we." Well, why did the apostles receive the Holy Ghost? Why did they receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit upon that first Pentecost after the death of Christ upon the cross? It came; that the people might know that Peter and the other apostles were preaching the gospel, and were inspired and commanded by God. It didn't save them on the day of Pentecost; neither did it save Cornelius. For it's very purpose in coming upon Cornelius was to prove to Peter and these other Jews that God had granted repentance unto life, unto those who were Gentiles.

So it was that when Peter went back to Jerusalem, and stood up and proclaimed all the things that happened, then the scripture says, "They held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life." It was merely as a sign to show that these should accept the gospel and become fellow Christians and fellow saints in the Lord; But notice this one thing: Peter says, "Can any man forbid water, that these should be baptized?" This must have been an exciting time to all present and we know that it was imbedded in their hearts all the rest of their lives. Can you not picture Peter, who had been taught all of his life that the Gentiles were with out hope and to be shunned, not receiving them. Under the Old Law he had been taught that the Israelite was not to marry the Gentile and he even considered those who intermarried as dogs. Now he turns and asks the Jewish Christians, "Can any man forbid water that these should be baptized?" He was no longer the Peter that refused to eat God's creation because he considered it unclean. He so to speaks stands with outstretched arms beseeching the Gentile to come to the Lord.

Try also to imagine the emotions of Cornelius, a devout man, but one who lacked something and now he is to be told by Peter, a Jew, what he must do to present himself acceptable unto God. This was the reality of hope.

Cornelius, a devout man, one who feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people and prayed to God always, was the man to be baptized in the name of the Lord. A good man, yet he needed more; he needed to accept the word of Jehovah. He needed to be in the Lord's kingdom; he needed to be ready for the Lord to come. He had not obeyed the gospel. The apostle Paul declares what will the end of such in II Thessalonians. "Christ shall come with his power of angels in flaming fire, taking vengeance on them that know not God and obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ."

My friend, no matter how good a person you are, unless you obey the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ, Christ is coming with flaming fire and to take vengeance. It's my prayer; it's my plea that you won't have to face the vengeance of God and Christ. Won't you accept him? Won't you be like Cornelius? Won't you hear the word and be baptized? Study diligently, and live a good clean life for the Lord. Won't you do that? Perhaps there are some in the audience today; perhaps there are hundreds and thousands who never saw this. No matter how good you are; you still have to accept Christ, or you will stand in condemnation in God on the judgment day. Won't you accept him? Won't you obey him? Believe with all of your heart; repent; confess his holy name, and be buried with him in baptism. Won't you do that? It is our fervent prayer and plea that you'll be able to sing with us that stirring song "Just As I Am"; with a spirit of understanding and readiness to go to the Lord. Won't you now resolve to accept him while we sing?



## CHRIST WITHOUT SIN

We as citizens of the United States pride ourselves in our zeal for justice. Our courts are founded on the principles of justice; our armies have been used for the aid of protecting the mistreated and enslaved people of the world; we as a people quickly leap to the assistance of the little man who is treated in injustice. Yet we as a religious people seem to forget these fine principles when we turn to the God of heaven. We are inclined to go along with the murderers and dictators of religion.

Although this incident, that I want us to remember this morning, happened over 1900 years ago, many of us by our actions and words are endorsing the wrong doing that occurred then. There was a man who was by trade a carpenter. He had been reared by good parents and had as a boy worked in his father's carpenter shop. He was not a wealthy boy, but was strong and healthy. He was liked by the neighbors and worked hard. Today we might call a lad of such character a good American boy. Yet he was not an American, he was of the same family as King David, that great king of Israel.

This boy had been hated all his life by those who were the dictators of religion at that time as well as the dictators of politics. When he was twelve years old he astounded the learned men at the Temple where his parents came to worship. These men had never really met opposition and therefore were aroused that this mere lad should question and answer them. Although this boy had great knowledge, we must not in any way suppose that he was egotistical or arrogant. He acted just as the humble carpenter's son.

This boy for thirty years prepared himself for a great work. He sought to know people and their troubles. His heart did not become hardened as many do when they are faced with trouble and injustice each day, but he poured out his heart for the people and tears could be found on the cheeks of this one as he beheld the people. We know little of the life of this boy until he was thirty, yet he must have filled it full.

Around this time there was a great preacher and prophet in that section of the country. He sought to bring the people to repentance and in doing so did not spare words in protest against the religious dictators. Well, one day this young man we have been talking about came down to the river Jordan and asked to be baptized of this preacher, whose name was John. Immediately John cried out that he wasn't even worthy to stoop down and unloose this shoe strings. But this young man insisted that he be baptized to fulfill all prophecy. Then as that young man came up out of the water "The Spirit of God descended like a dove, and lighted upon him; and lo, a voice from heaven said, 'This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.'" Matthew 3:16-17. So with that recognition and identification Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God, set out on a road of great works.

Jesus was one who hated to see people oppressed and yet did not curse the men who were responsible for all the misery. He set about to preach the gospel of freedom and to practice the healing of the sick and afflicted. The first miracle Christ performed was for the hostess who had become embarrassed at a wedding feast; he turned water into wine. His heart always was poured out for those who were in difficulty.

When men of faith cried out to heal them, He immediately turned to care for them. He was indeed the great physician. He gave the blind sight; the dumb speech; the lame steps and the sick health. Where he walked it was as God had touched the healing hands of nature. His life was to thousands as perfume in land that was sinking with corruption and sickness.

Yet he was not only satisfied to help those people living in His age, but sought through a doctrine of love to establish freedom and security to all that would follow Him even after death. He taught the people what it means to love thy neighbor. Oh, how I wish I could have heard Him tell with His own lips that marvelous story of the good Samaritan found in Luke 10:25-37. "And behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and

tempted him saying, "Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? He said unto him, 'What is written in the law? how readest thou?' And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself. And he said unto him, Thou hast answered right: this do, and thou shalt live. But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour? And Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. And by chance there came down a certain priest that way: and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. And likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came and looked on him, and passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, and went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. And on the morrow when he departed, he took out two pence, and gave them to the host, and said unto him, Take care of him; and whatsoever thou spendest more, when I come again, I will repay thee. Which now of these three, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among thieves? And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise." To the people such stories were strange and the gospel He preached was something new. To the majority their lives had only known and felt greed, hate, and jealousy. While there were thousands that followed Him and listened intently to every word that was spoken, some were plotting in secret to trap this young man who led and taught the people.

These religious dictators were beginning to lose their hold on the people and thus Jesus was leading the people back to only the laws of God. Surely, these unrighteous men taught the law of God, but they rendered it useless by changing and adding to the laws to suit their own lusts and to line their pockets. They had become so entranced in the upholding the doctrines they had created that God and His love were forgotten.

Even though Jesus knew that the religious laws under which His people worshipped were coming to an end, He did not rail against them, but sought to live in accordance to the spirit and letter of the law given by Moses. While He was merciful and meek, He spoke bravely and straight-forwardly to those men who sought to rule the people. He was ever ready to uphold the weak; help the needy; heal the sick, and attack the unjust. No stronger words could have been uttered than those spoken in rebuke and warning to the Scribes and Pharisees, the proud, self-righteous.

Because He had the courage to stand up against evil, He made many enemies. Just as men and women today will arise to satisfy their own pride and attack the leaders of justice and peace, so then there were many who thought more of their power than all mankind.

These men, working under the dark cloak of religious pride devised many plans to overcome this young preacher and leader. Many failed, but finally through bribery, one of Christ's chosen men was persuaded to betray Christ.

You know when times are fine and we have something to offer others, we don't have any trouble finding many who will follow and want to be with us. But let disaster come and they flee as birds. Well, that was what happened to this brilliant young man whom we know as the Son of God. All but a few forsook Him completely and turned to be enemies. And all but one of these that did not completely forsake Him, followed afar off.

This young man who did nothing but good and only thought of the welfare of people was now forsaken in the hour of trial. The wicked and self-righteous mocked Him, spat on Him, cursed Him, beat Him; yet not one word did he speak in return. Though even in pain, He refused to rebel against these who misused Him. Then there came his trial. The people who had followed Him and had been healed by Him were aroused by the cunningness of the wicked, and cried out that He must be crucified. Witnesses were paid to life against Christ and to reach the peak of injustice, the judge sentenced Him to be crucified in order to please the people.



And so was it with the life of this brilliant young man, even the Son of God. Though His lips, His hands, feet nor heart had never committed sin, He was doomed to die the death of the worst criminal. While His life had been spent in helping others and doing good to all, in death He was mocked.

Today millions look backward to that life and that death. The day He was raised from the dead is a day observed by millions. Our stores and way of life pause on Sunday and many think of Him and what He stood for. Our time is reckoned in accordance with His life.

Yet all this is not enough. Remember what He stood for and did. Peter explains it in these words, "Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: who did no sin; neither was guile found in his mouth; who, when reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously; who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness; by whose stripes ye were healed." I Peter 2:21-24. We may speak of Washington, Lincoln, Wilson, and Roosevelt, but these are not even worthy to touch the hem of the garment of Christ. We owe everything to Christ, who died for us. He was mistreated and suffered injustice, so why should we not spring to His defense? Why should we not help bear the cross and glorify His name? The only thing that is asked of us is to obey His commands. He said, "If you love me you will keep my commands." So let us turn with joy to the Holy Word and hear his commands. We must follow His example and rise against the religious dictators that try to rule the people by their own doctrines. We must obey only the commands of Christ as He commanded and taught us to do. The only way we can become free from sin and the bondage of self-righteousness is to throw off their doctrines and books. By thier much writings they seek to enslave you, but by the Word of God, which Christ calls the truth in John 17, we may be free: "Ye shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free." John 8:32.

My friends, the greatest thing you could ever do is to resolve today to throw off the cloak of denominationalism and obey the simple commands of Christ. Believe with all your heart in Christ and God; repent of every sin; confess the name of Christ; and be baptized in His name for the remission of sins. Then and only then will you be free from sin and the bondage of the sinful. Christ died without sin that we might be cleansed of our sins. Is it too much for us to in turn follow Him? If we forsake Him we might as well hae cried, "Crucify Him crucify Him." You might as well have driven the nails into the hands and feet of the sinless Christ, your saviour and mine. Christ gave His life for us. Won't you give yourself in obedience today for Him? You will be lifting the hand of righteousness and striking at Satan and his works. You will be gighting the injustice of sin and living for Christ, our Saviour, who gave His
