

THE SEARCH FOR THE GIANT ARCTIC JELLYFISH is a humorous tale of Dr. Morley's search for the giant arctic creature. During her quest, she and her crew see narwhals, ducks, seals, orcas, beluga whales, the aurora borealis, and polar bears but never see the giant arctic jellyfish that is hiding in each illustration.

The illustrations are colorful and depict the light exquisitely. The book includes a map and pictures of gear used on the expedition as well as a unique cutaway of the research ship that shows the different facilities in the research vessel: the bridge, kitchen, bathroom, bedrooms, engine room, storage, and lab. The book is a great source that depicts researchers at work, and I would recommend using it above the suggested PK-3 grade levels.
