Christ Is The Answer

1 Is not man searching for the cure to a heartsick world? The history of our generation and generations gone by is filled with the seeking of a way to calm the troubled world. Our prisons and our hospitals are monuments to the failure of men in finding the answer. Leagues and conferences, federations and councils have been swept away by the machines of war. They have not been the answer. Psychiatrists and psychologists have not been able to meet the demand of their patients for help. It seems that everything that man has ever thought or ever conceived as a means by which the troubled heart of man might be calmed has ended in failure.

The question echoes, "is the human race destined to an infamous finish? A race of degenerates, neurotics? Is the cry of the infidel true, 'there is no life beyond the grave?' Is it our destiny to return body and soul to ashes?"

3 There never has been a way nor a frug invented by man that could prevent it. But, my friends, do not lose hope, there is an answer. There is an answer for your troubled heart, there is an answer for your yearning and longing for peace, there is an answer for life. Christ is the answer. But we must receive Him and hear Him, and follow Him. --Our trouble today is that same trouble of 2,000 years ago.

John the Baptizer was sent into the world to prepare the way for Christ. I like to think of John as the trail-blazer cutting his way through the jungle of sin that Christ the King might follow. John indeed, with his words, cut deep into the hearts of his hearers. And by the time that Christ came, many had been aroused to a fervor, and expectancy for the king. John indeed, as the trail-blazer, was a great man, and yet he is not the answer nor the one for us to follow, for Christ is the King and the answer. Christ said of John, "Verily, I say unto you, among them that are born of woman, there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist, notwithstanding he that is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he." Matthew 11:11. Well, what was Christ trying to say? Just that there was none greater as mortal man, but that the least in the kingdom of Christ was greater than John, for John wasn't even in the kingdom. In fact, the kingdom was not established until after John had been beheaded by Herod.

5 But in the first part of the 11th chapter of Matthew, we find that John had been cast into prison, and while he was in prison, he heard of the mighty works that Christ was performing, and he wondered if this man could be the savior for whom he had prepared the way. So he sent two of his disciples to ask this stirring question: "Art thou he that should come, or do we look for another?" Then Christ did a

strange thing. Instead of answering directly, he told these two men, "Go and show John again those things which you do hear and see. The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear. The dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached unto them, and blessed is he whosoever shall not be offended in me." Matthew 11:4-6. I wonder what John's conclusion was when he heard of these mighty works of Christ? I am sure that he did not look for another, but was convinced that this indeed was the savior.

Today, men and women who are not in prison actually, still ask that same question concerning Christ and his way. They seem to eternally seek for something new and modern. We hear men speaking about the modern Christ, for a modern generation, and I recently heard a woman talking about how much she enjoyed modern religion. I am sincerely convinced that instead of it being a modern Christ or a modern religion, it is only a perverted Christ and a vain religion. I think it well therefore that we stop and consider Christ and His way. Do we need a new Christ? Do we need a new way? Or more specifically, shall we ask Christ, "art thou he that saves the world, or do we look for another?"

When I, first of all, think of Christ, I remember that the great apostle Paul said that He is the head over all things to the church, which is His body. Then if Christ is head of the church, what more should we ask concerning His relationship to the church? I would not want to seek another, for Christ is the head. Yet not only is Christ the head of the church, but in Acts the 2nd chapter we find the apostle Peter saying, "Therefore let all of the house of Israel know assuredly that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye crucified, both Lord and Christ." Then if Christ is the Lord, can any other be higher than He?

I find also that Christ is our mediator with God, for we find the writer of Hebrews testifying to the fact that He hath become our high priest forever. And because He continues forever, "hath an unchangeable priesthood, wherefore He is also able to save them to the uttermost, that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them." Hebrews 7:25. Then again we hear John being moved by the Holy Spirit, testifying, "And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the father, Jesus Christ the righteous." Whom else should I seek, and what more should I want, than to have the sinless and beloved son of God seated upon the right hand of the throne of God, pleading and making intercession for me when I sin.

But still more than that, Christ is the savior. The angle in Matthew, chapter 1, proclaimed this fact concerning His coming, "He shall save His people from their sins." His very life was spent in helping and saving others, and His precious blood was shed that you and I might have hope of

eternal life. We hear the writer of Hebrews saying, "And He hath become the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him." Hebrews 5:9. If then Christ is the author of eternal salvation, who else should I seek. Why should I turn from His holy countenance, and follow after mortal man?

But not only doth Christ hold salvation, but we find Him saying, in Rev. 1:18, "Fear not; I am the first and the last; I am He that liveth and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore, amen, and have the keys of death and hell." I want you to stop just for a moment and think what that means: that Christ has the keys to death and hell. Those two words stamp on my heart a heavy veil of blackness and night. Try, if you can to envision yourself as being locked in a huge room, where there was no light of any kind. This room has only one door, and there is only one individual who has the keys to open this door. Would you not seek to become acquainted with this one, so that the door might be opened? Well, it's that same way with Christ. Where waits for us an everlasting chasm of darkness and destruction if we do not know Christ, and Christ does not know us. For He holds the keys to death and to hell. Why, oh why, should anyone want to seek longer. Is not Christ enough? Is not His power by which the world was created, enough? Is not His love, which prompted His giving of His life enough? Is not His way the best way?

But there is one more thing that I want us to mention concerning Christ; in Him there is unbroken fellowship! As every minute moves along, there is another minute that has separated farther the fellowship that we had with someone. Perhaps we stand before the open tomb, and grieve the broken fellowship of one we have loved so well, or we may stand at the curb and watch loved ones drive away, never to be seen again. There is no fellowship of this life that will not sometime be broken. But through the holy word of Christ we find a comforting promise. Lo, I will be with you always, even unto the end of the world. Just think, Christ will be with us in sickness and death, in life and in health, in our sorrows, in peace, and strife. Oh, yes, there is in Christ an unbroken fellowship. In none other can I find such a promise, so why should I seek for anything more different. To me, Christ, and Christ alone, is enough. I don't want Him modernized, or perverted, or changed, because then He would cease to be Christ, the son of God. For I find the writer of Hebrews saying, "Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, and today, and forevermore." Hebrews 13:8. Therefore, the only thing I can believe is that Christ is the one for which I seek, and I need not look for another.

And yet is not Christ's way and gospel sufficient? Should I seek for more? The apostle Paul loudly proclaims, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God, the salvation to everyone who believeth."

For what more could I ask?

13 However, there are some who say that "we want something new and something modern" and they seek after some new way in which they can build for themselves denominations. I find the word of God teaching that upon simple obedience to the gospel, the Lord added men and women to the church which Christ built and of which He is the head. In Acts 2, the gospel was preached and many believed, being cut to the heart, because they had crucified the Lord, and cried out, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" There is no reason that we should give any other answer than that which the inspired Peter gave on that occasion, given in Acts 2:38, "Then Peter said unto them, repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Then in the 41st verse the writer says, "Then they that gladly received His word were baptized: and the sameday there were added unto them about three thousand souls." If on the day of Pentecost it took hearing, believing, repenting and being baptized for the remission of sin to be added to the Church, and thereby become part of the body of Christ, then why should I seek for anything more? Let us be satisfied with the everlasting truths that are just as fresh and alive today as they were two thousand years ago.

Oh, how I wish that I could get men and women, boys and girls to realize that in Christ there is salvation, and that He is the head of the church, king and ruler. There is no need of turning to other men, for we have found Christ, the hope of the world. Shall we say in the words of Christ, "The blind receive their sight, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear; the dead are raised up and the poor have the gospel preached to them, and blessed is he whosoever shall not be offended in me."

15 Instead of us seeking for something new, we should all lift our voices in a cry to return to the old paths. Let us turn back unto the word of God as our only source of authority, back unto Christ as our only savior, back to His way as the only way, back into His church as the only church. We need that old-time religion of Peter and Paul and James, Jude and John. We need to hark back to the savior. I am afraid that many of us have passed Him by, and we seek in vain. Lay aside every form of the doctrines of man and accept Christ and His word.

Oh, yes, we can answer that question. We have found the Christ. He can be real in your heart, and in my heart if we only obey in simple love and trust. But when we truly obey Christ, we must remember that there is no room for any other, save Jesus, who died on the cross for our sins. In Him alone is there salvation; in Him alone is there hope of everlasting life. It is my fervent prayer that you will not turn from His pleading cry, but you will rise up and say,

"Here am I, Lord, and I am willing to do what thou would have me to do, for I have found you, and thou art real, and thou will save me." Then when men ask of the Christ, you and I, having obeyed His blessed word, may say with the apostle Peter in Acts 4:12, "Neither is there salvation in any other, for there is none other name unto heaven given to men whereby we must be saved." Let us all read God's holy word and know Christ as He would have it to know Christ as He is and the church as He would have it to be. And let us do as Andrew did; let us go and tell out brethren, "Come; we have found the Christ." Christ is the answer, if we obey Him.

Christ, The Vine

In the fifteenth chapter of John, we find one of the most realistic parables that Christ ever told: "I am the vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit, he taketh away; and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in Him, the same bringeth forth such fruit; for without me ye can do nothing. If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples."

Did you ever think of yourself as a branch of the true vine? Did you ever think of yourself as being a part of the body of Christ? If you have accepted the Lord, that's exactly what you are. If you have been born anew; if you have been buried with Christ in baptism, if you have been baptized into Christ, you are a part of Christ. You are a part of the true vine. Christ, here in the fifteenth chapter of John says that He is the true vine, that His father is the true husbandman, and that you and I, and all others who are Christians are the branches. Now, I want us to think about being branches of Christ. "I am the vine and ye are the branches. He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit, for without me ye can do nothing."

I wish that every soul would sit down and read that one verse: "for without me, ye can do nothing." The apostle Peter expressed it in these words, "There is none other name under heaven whereby we must be saved." There is not a thing that we can accomplish for good that will endure throughout and past our life without Christ. "Without me" He says, "Ye can do nothing." Oh, we accomplish things that will bring glory to us; we can do things for vain glory of life, but if Christ is not with us, it will not endure. "Abide in me, and I in you." Did you ever see a branch that could bear fruit apart from the vine? At home, we have a great many grapevines in the backyard. Each summer I enjoy going out and eating the grapes right off the vine. Yet, I know, and anyone who has seen a vine will know the vine bears fruit through the branches. But if the branch is taken away from the vine, then will it bear no

fruit.

Christ bears fruit through you and me as Christians. He bears fruit through us and through us only. And if we become separated from Christ, then there will be no fruit born. If we let sin come into our lives and separate us, and that's the only thing that separated us from Christ; if we let sin contaminate our hearts and contaminate our lives, then there will be no fruit born for Christ.

So few of us realize that God has willed that he should this day and age act only through his children. Christ wills that he will have no hands but our hands with which to minister to suffering mankind; no feet but ours to lead, by way of example, men in paths of righteousness; no tongue but to preach His everlasting truths. If we separate ourselves from Christ we have separated ourselves from the force of life and have rendered useless our services as branches through us into the hearts and lives of those about us. Apart from me, Christ said, you can do nothing.

One thing that is distressing about this passage of scripture is that it is so often misapplied and misinterpreted. Men today, to uphold modern denominationalism, will read this and say "I am the vine, and you are the branches," trying to prove that Christ is the vine, and denominationalism makes up the branches. But nothing could be so much farther from the truth than that very one theory. Hear the words of the scripture here: "I am the vine, ye are the branches. If a man abide not in me he is cast forth as a branch." If a man. It's not groups of individuals, it's not denominations, that make up the branches, but it is each individual Christian. Notice Christ said that a man is the branch, and he, a man or individual, would be cast forth. There is no way that you can construe this passage of scripture to make the denominations the branches. If this theory could be true, then the sinful life of one individual in a denomination would cause the whole denomination to be lost. "For if a man," Christ says, "abide not in me the branch is cast forth. We are held responsible as individuals for our faith and our works. Every man shall be judged according to his own works. The apostle Paul says in Romans 14:10, "For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of God." And again in II Corinthians 5:10, "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad." When you and I forsake the Lord; when you and I become so puffed up with pride that we think that we can substitute and that we can change, that we know more than the Lord, then we are separating ourselves from the source of life, and of strength. We are separating ourselves from the Christ, the vine. And when we are separated from Christ and the vine, the scripture says that the branch is withered up, and they will be gathered together and cast in the fire and burned. I heard someone one time say, "You peo-

ple are so narrowminded you think that if people do not obey exactly what the scripture says, that they are not a member of the church which Christ established, and that they are going to be lost. You're narrow." But I'm reminded of the words of one grand old preacher, who said, "I will go even farther than that. I do not believe that all of those that are members of the body of Christ will be saved." Yes, many branches will be cut off and burned.

My friends, no matter how much you think that you are right with God, unless according to the word you are a part of that vine and you keep yourself close to Christ, you would not be bearing and fruit and if you separate yourself from Christ, you will be withered up and cast into the fire. Could there be any passage of scripture that would teach any more against the doctrine of the impossibility of falling from grace? "Men will be gathered up and cast into the fire, and they are burned." Oh, how I wish that men would realize that Christ, and Christ alone, is the true vine. Martin Luther is not the vine: John Wesley is not the vine: John Smith is not the vine, but Christ said, "I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman." It is the duty of the husbandman of the vineyard to go about in the vineyard and to purge the vines that they might grow, that they might produce fruit. A vine that has a lot of branches on it that are not bringing forth fruit is a vine whose productivity is being cut. The husbandman goes about cutting off these nuisances, branches that are part of the vine. If you and I let our lives become useless, if we fill our lives with the cares of this world, and crowd out the words of the Lord, Jesus Christ, then God, as the husbandman, is going to purge the vine of the useless branches.

You may rest assured that if we conform our lives with the ways of the world that at the day of judgment, we as branches that brought forth no fruit, will be cast off and cast into the fire. Let us not seek for unjust mercy from God. For God, as the husbandman, has the responsibility of caring for the vine, and he could not be just to the fruit bearing branch nor to Christ, the vine, if he did not purge and cleanse the vine, or the church of our Saviour. That is why we must so diligently heed the words of the apostle Paul in Romans 12:2, "Be ye not conformed to this world, but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind."

No man is the vine, but Christ and Christ alone, so why do not we, through the words of Christ and in obedience to Him draw ourselves nigh unto Christ, the vine, the hope of the world and ever keep ourselves close in obedience, and true love of the vine, Jesus of Nazareth.

But you have to obey. You have to accept Him through the gospel. The writer of Hebrews says, speaking of Christ, "He is the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him." Notice that Christ said, "I am the vine and ye

are the branches. Ye abide in me." The apostle Paul in Galations 3:27 tells us how that we are placed in Christ. For as many of you who have been baptized into Christ, have put on Christ." It is only by the obedience of the commands of Christ that we can abide in Him. So why should not you do that? Would not you come now? Forget about all the doctrines of today. Forget about the idea that "take the church of your choice." That's not the teaching of the New Testament. It never was. There is no choice to make. God had made the choice. The only choice that we have is whether we are going to heaven or whether we are going to hell, that's the choice we have. There is no choice of vines; there is no choice of branches, because you as an individual become a branch when you obey the gospel.

Come, dear friend, will you not accept Christ: Will you not accept obedience to the gospel, repent of your sins, having believed with all of your heart, confess the name of Christ, be buried with him in baptism? The words of the Lord come to us in these words: "Without faith it is impossible to be well-pleasing to Him, for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and the Lord says, "Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." And the apostle Paul says, "For with the heart, man believeth unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." And the apostle Peter says, "Baptism doth now save us." And the apostle Paul relates to us how that he was told: "Why tarriest thou? Arise and be baptised, washing away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord."

I ask the question, "Why tarry? Why should you wait? Why should you not come to Christ today, and become a branch of the true vine, Jesus Christ?" And Christian friend, if you have become as a branch that is useless to the vine, will you not come back? Will you not come back today? Will you not seek out your brother and both of you pray together that the God of love will forgive your sins. Oh, will you not come? There could not be any force stronger pulling you than the love of Christ, that He gave up His life that you and I might have salvation. Can you reject it? Can you afford to turn away when you realize that either you accept Him or you will face the punishment of eternity? Will you not heed to these loving words as He pleads and begs with you to come: "Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

With the end of the month of March, we, the elders of Highland Church of Christ in Abilene, and all those who are helping to make possible these broadcasts of the Herald of Truth, have much to be thankful for. During this second month of broadcasting, we have seen and read things that are indeed gratifying to us, and that make our efforts seem more and more worthwhile.

We receive weekly hundreds of letters from men and women who are interested in the truth, and we feel sure that within a short while that many of these will respond to the will of Christ. We wish it were possible to publish in this booklet many of the cards and letters received in our office but space will not permit.

There is another work of the Herald of Truth that we

know is doing much good. A lady in Baltimore writes, "I have been a member of the church for many years, but since moving to Baltimore, I have been unable to find a congregation of the Lord's Church." Through our extensive files we had the information concerning a congregation worshipping in Baltimore, and we wrote to her, giving her this information. We trust that she is now worshipping with them there and this child of God will cease to wander without Christian companionship.

In the middle of February a call was sent out to our supporting congregations, informing them that unless \$52,000 was raised immediately that some of our stronger stations in areas where the church is weak must be dropped. Response to this call was heart-warming. Many congregations, too numerous to name, replied something like this "We cannot withdraw the gospel from souls who have already been allowed a taste. We are increasing our support \$10 per week." A few ... "We will double our support." and still yet a few ... "We don't feel we can keep it up, but until this deficit is met you can count on us for \$5 per week more." We are very happy to be able to report that not one station was dropped. These pledge increases, along with contributions from interested individuals, have temporarily met the crisis. However, if we are to meet our goal of the entire ABC network, we will need approximately \$100,000 more per year.

We wish our report to you could all be rosy, but we still get letters about which we are able to do nothing, such as this one from North Carolina: "I talked with the station manager, and they are anxious to be included in the network. To my knowledge there is no place in the U.S. where the gospel preaching is needed more than here. There are four small congregations in this immediate area, (two of these started last fall), and only one owns a building to meet in. The other three are struggling hard to be able to build this summer and fall. Hence none are financially able to support the radio program. There are a few other congregations within the listening area also, that would be benefited much. We hope and pray you brethren will give this appeal your earnest consideration and if possible at all, include our station. This 'desert of sorrow and sin' needs help.

We have added a few stations recently, most of which are supported entirely by the congregation in that city or some congregation directly interested in that city. We hope to be able to add several more soon. You will find in the back pages our up-to-date station list. We will try to keep you informed with the latest developments each month.
