mation in reference to property here. The price of land from one to five miles from Gainesville varies according to location and character of soil, ranging from say \$25.00 to \$100.00 per acre. You can get farm labor here from \$20.00 to \$30.00 per month; carpenters get from \$2.00 to \$3.00 per day, and there is plenty of that work to do, houses going up all the time. If you have been taking the paper published in our town you are pretty familiar with the conditions here, as the paper gives very good information. The climate and water here cannot be surpassed in the United States in my opinion, and I am sure that the change would more than likely result in good for yourself and family.

You can raise almost anything here that grows in a mild climate and can get from two to three crops each year on the same land.

This community here engages principally in vegetable growing. If you wish to correspond with some farmers here. I will give you the following names:- Mr. Aleck Daughtry - Mr. Nimrod Wells, both of Gainesville. I believe, however, that the best thing for you to do is to come down and look things over personally, because I believe you will find our farmers and laborers are too busy to pay much attention to correspondence, and it is very likely that you will not get much information by letter from them. So the thing to do is to

come and look it over, and if it comes up to what you expect invest your money and become a citizen, and I am sure you will never regret.
