INSIDE THE BERMUDA TRIANGLE is part of the Alternator Books: Top Secret series. The Bermuda Triangle has been the topic of questions, superstition, and mystery. This book tells the stories of a number of planes and ships that seemed to disappear within the imaginary triangle. Its corners align with Florida, Bermuda, and Puerto Rico. There are a lot of concepts, history, and geography included in this book that make it appropriate for older elementary readers. The glossary provided at the end may help with defining vocabulary, such as "anomaly" and "speculate." However, concepts such as "unusual natural phenomena" and "human error" must be figured out by using context clues.
