Dear Sister Jackson:

Brother Larimore has referred part of your letter to me for attention. I believe that the climate in Florida will suit you, as the winters are mild and we have a great many bright days - in fact very few of any other kind. Gainesville is not what might be termed a regular tourist town but is a home town, and I believe it would appeal to you to spend your winters in such a place. It is quiet enough for one to have all the rest they wish, and there are many attractive places, drives, etc., that would be interesting to one spending some time here.

Board can be procured for from \$7.00 to \$15.00 per week; it varies, of course, according to the sort of accommodations required. Perhaps it might suit you better to secure apartments or a cottage, as I am informed by Mrs. Larimore that you have your own servant, and then you could carry on the house to suit your own convenience and have things just as you wish them. If you wish to secure a house or apartment would be glad to do what I can to get it for you, or will investigate the different places suitable for boarding.
