New Mission Point Near Lake City, Fla.

The writer at a great sacrifice has opened a new mission point eight miles from Lake City, Fla., (the home of the writer,) where I have preached a few times at a school house (owned by an individual), and while there are no members of "The Church of Christ" there, it is in a splendid locality thickly settled by farmers and we believe a good prospect to establish New Testament Christianity. In fact our faith in this was strong enough to prompt me to buy the house, (at a great bargain), when the opportunity afforded. The house is 25x32 feet, solid lumber and sealed, with 17 home-made benches, a good heater stove and a blackboard. One acre of land (with deed in the deed), deeded to myself and Bro. J. F. Howell as the trustees for "The Liberty Church of Christ", this being the new name for that place of worship.

Some necessary repairs on the house and a few more benches, Insurance premium on it (for we have it insured for \$300) together with some incidental expenses. It was necessary for me to borrow \$150 with which to pay for it. The house and fixtures are well worth \$400 and I not feeling able to make this sacrifice alone, I am now asking my Brethren in Christ to help me raise this amount with which to pay this debt, which will open the way to give the Gospel to those who have never heard it in its purity, thereby saving souls, establishing an Apostolic "Church of Christ" and honoring God. I am preaching there once a month (two sermons each day) and will continue to do so until we can establish the cause of Christ there.

I have engaged the services of Brother W. S. Long, Jr., of Memphis, Tenn., to conduct a series of meetings of two weeks' duration at that place in February, 1914, at which time we hope to save many souls by the help of God and establish a "Church of Christ." Bro. Long will also need financial support in this meeting. Brethren in Christ who will be led to assist in this worthy work, will please send your contributions to me at this place. Who will help us?
