Dear Brethren:-

We, the undersigned Elders of the Church of Christ at Dukes, Fla., in behalf of the great cause of Christ at this place, do most sincerely appeal to you for financial aid with which to build a small meeting house at this place, costing about \$500.00. We have the lot secured, (with restrictive clause in the deed,) also about \$200.00 subscribed by the few Brethren who worship here, and work will begin on the house at once and pushed to its completion. But we are not financially able to complete the House without help; therefore, we come to you in the Name of Christ and ask you to have fellowship with us to the amount of \$300.00 with which to finish the House. Brethren, souls are dying for the lack of the Gospel and we need a house in which to preach it.

Will you hear and obey the call and thus help to save a soul? or refuse to heed the call and thus be responsible for the loss of a soul for whom Christ died and for which you will have to answer in "the great day of judgment" Ezek. 3:17-19.
