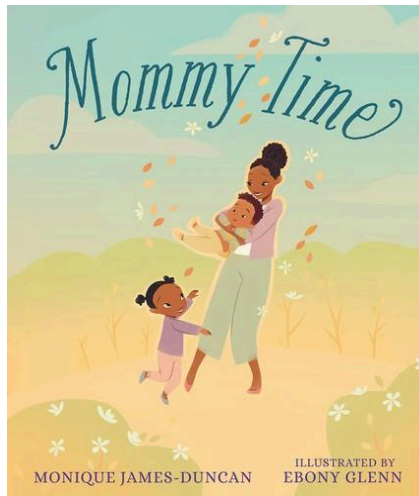

Book Review: MOMMY TIME

This rhyming story winds its way through a busy day with the stay-at-home Mommy and all the things she makes time to do with the two children. It begins with eating breakfast and getting one child ready for school and the other ready for a big day of playing in all kinds of places (singing and dancing with other children and mommies, building with blocks, shopping, going to the playground) and then back home for lunch. The afternoon is filled with helping around the house, napping, snacking, and finally going off to pick up sister from school. Then it's off to the library, the dentist, a stroll in the park, kickball time, and FINALLY supertime with Daddy.

This book could inspire good discussion about readers' own time with their mommies and daddies and might bring issues to light that could have a bearing on children's behaviors. The illustrations are pretty much one-dimensional but cute.
