Biographical Note: Frank L. Cox was born in 1895 in Farmersville, Texas. He attended Abilene Christian College from 1913-1914 and graduated from Thorps Spring Christian College in 1917. He began preaching in Baird, Texas in 1913. Along with a career as a preacher, he was also a prolific writer. He wrote many books, was a staff writer for *Gospel Advocate*, and served as editor for *The Spotlight* and *Minister's Monthly*. He served as an elder at Glenwood Church of Christ in Tyler, Texas from 1959 until his death in 1978.
