Scope and Content Note: This collection contains some of the personal notebooks of Alfred Ellmore.

Biographical Note: Alfred Ellmore was born in southern Indiana in 1838. He knew his desire to preach from a young age. Ellmore began preaching in 1865. Along with preaching, he also wrote for periodicals, such as *Gospel Advocate*, *Christian Leader*, and *Gospel Echo* and these books: *Which is the True Church?* (1877); *Maple Valley Poems* (1892); *Gems, Proverbs and Allegories* (1912); and *Sermons and Sayings* (1918). He served as president of Gunter Bible College in Gunter, Texas from 1912 to 1922. After this, he returned to his native Indiana. He died in 1925 from complications associated with a broken hip.
