1000 Nuggets of Gold

OR

CHOICE SCRIPTURES TO MARK AND
MEMORIZE

*"More to be desired are they than gold,
yea than much fine gold."*

(Psalm 19: 10.)

The Bible has the most beautiful and helpful language in the world, and will do more to make men happy than all other books combined. If your child is well acquainted with it, he is appreciated in English classes in school. How many passages of it can YOU quote? How many does your child know from memory? Think of it, brethren! **You will coax, and threaten, and bribe, and ding-dong on your child to practice on its music lesson AN HOUR EVERY DAY, and yet you will not have it practice fifteen minutes A WEEK on the Word of God which will bring true music to the soul!** Music is a mere accomplishment for time, but a knowledge of the Word of God is an accomplishment for eternity. I sometimes wonder whether we are Christians at all, or are mere heathen! We surely have no proper sense of values.

Listen to this: If you should have your child memorize only two choice verses each week, that would mean 100 choice passages a year. (And by all means, there should be constant review.) If you commence when the child is five years old (you could commence earlier), **by the time it is 15 years old, it would have 1000 choice passages of God's Word**

to guide it—just at the age when it is starting out in life alone and when it needs it most. And if it has learned, in addition, most of the Bible stories and the lessons taught of right and wrong, it has a foundation of Christian living which it will be hard for the devil to shake.

You may never be able to leave your child a farm or a good business. You may not be able to put him through college or even through high school. But here is an education which EVERY parent can give his child, no matter how poor, and which he SHOULD give it. Here is treasure which you can give it which is more to be desired than gold. It costs only a little faith and labor on your part.

Many who read this may be living back in hills and hollows, on poor farms, or "across the railroad tracks" in towns and cities. And yet in your poverty and lack of opportunities, you can give your child without such opportunities the best education one can possess, and the greatest riches one can enjoy. You can, by spending a few minutes each day, inject into his growing and receptive mind, the most helpful ideas in the world, and you can make him an heir to mansions in the skies. Think of it, brethren!

I tell you, that your child who goes out into the sinful world with those Bible stories and the lessons of warning and hope for which God ordained them, and with **one thousand choice passages of Scripture** stored in a reverential mind—goes out into the world better prepared to meet its temptations and to do good in it and to be happy, than the child who goes out with a college training, or a million dollars, WITHOUT that religious training. He has that which will make him more agreeable to his fellowmen, give him more satisfaction in all his affairs, and render him more happy than all the college training and money which the world can give.

We now give you references to hundreds of choice passages of Scripture which will help you if you will mark them in your Bible, and perhaps memorize them; and you may save your child if you will have him memorize them. A blue pencil will make the passages stand out better. Study the connection of each choice passage, if there is a connection of thought, and you will be laying up nuggets of gold for the proverbial rainy day of trouble and temptation in life. It will be a pleasant Bible course. The compiler is giving you what has helped him through the years. Many of the connected verses make a train of thought for a short mid-week talk or Bible study. Here they are—
