Perhaps it would be appropriate here to make an appeal toward helping to reach a solution to a problem which has reached alarming proportions. Please do everything possible to discourage the current practice of some American tourists and some U. S. Servicemen of touring Europe as parasites, eating with and staying in the homes of gospel preachers as they travel from city to city. Some expect these busy evangelists to chauffeur them on personally guided tours of the city. All this adds up to an unbearable burden on the wives of these evangelists and a great loss of valuable time for the already overworked brethren, who are sacrificing in these mission fields and who are supported there for a purpose other than that of entertaining American tourists.

Even as desirable as the tourist may consider himself to be, and even as hospitable as the evangelists in Europe are, those who take advantage of their hospitality seriously interfere with their work and with their personal lives. Unless the evangelist and his wife insist and persist in insisting that you eat with them or spend the night in their home, please do not do so. If you wish to spend an hour or two visiting with them, as you probably will, and as they would also likely wish, invite the missionary and his family to have dinner with you at some nice restaurant in the city. If you are in the military, why not invite them to have an "American style" hamburger and milk shake with you. This would mean much to them, since they are not permitted to enjoy I. D. card privileges. In this way there can be a most pleasant visit, tension free, the "golden rule" will be practiced, and the evangelist's wife will not be burdened. Your visit will leave a lasting pleasant memory. Some are already doing this. Why not you, too, this year?
